



## ELIGIBILITY

- a. **Fair Play: Anti-Corruption Youth Voices** is open to any solo artist, band or group whose members are under 35 years of age, from any country;
- b. Maximum five (5) persons per band/group;
- c. Lyrics may be in any language, however, an English translation of all texts must be provided with application;
- d. Each artist/band/group may submit only one (1) entry;
- e. Deadline of submission of entries is **31 March 2010**. All email and post entries must be received by this date.

## GUIDELINES FOR ENTRY

The competition is open from **1 February 2010**. The following must be included for all entries:

- a. One (1) completed **Application Form**. See below!
- a. **Video performance** of one (1) original song on the theme of anti-corruption. Maximum running time is five (5) minutes per song. Video may be of a live performance, studio or other;
- b. **English translation** of all texts/lyrics (where song is in language other than English);

## SELECTION

- a. Upon submission, each entry shall be assessed by a panel composed of competition organizers and professionals from the field of music, according to the following criteria:

Quality of Composition	40 %
Anti-Corruption Campaign Relevance*	40 %
Musical Performance/Personality	20 %
TOTAL	100 %

\* *Anti-Corruption Campaign Relevance – The competition is part of a global anti-corruption campaign aimed at youth from post-conflict and developing countries. The campaign seeks to increase awareness among youth of the role they can play in fighting corruption in their countries, and builds a network where youth can develop their capacity to be effective agents of change and governance reform.*

- b. WBI and JMI shall select three (3) solo artists/bands/groups from any country, based on their submitted video, to perform at the **Global Youth Anti Corruption Network** meeting in Brussels, Belgium (May 2010 TBC);
- c. Selected artists/bands/groups will be notified through their indicated contact numbers about selection of artists to perform in Belgium;
- d. By entering the **Fair Play: Anti-Corruption Youth Voices** competition, the artists shall give WBI/JMI worldwide rights, including all intellectual property and interest that is created from such entry, to WBI/JMI. WBI/JMI shall own the copyright in each entry and each band waives the right of ownership for the submission in respect of commercial use, marketing and advertising. Once entered a band shall not be allowed to use said entry in any other competition or contest;
- e. By entering the **Fair Play: Anti-Corruption Youth Voices** competition, the artists agree to participate in related publicity and to the use of names and likenesses for the purposes of advertising, promotion and publicity without additional compensation. By entering, each member of the band/group releases and holds harmless WBI/JMI, its parents, subsidiaries, affiliates, directors, officers, employees and agents from any and all liability or injuries, loss or damage of any kind arising from or in connection with participation in the Contest or acceptance or use of any prize to the greatest extent as permitted by law;
- f. WBI and JMI reserve the right, in its sole discretion, to disqualify and remove any entry that does not comply with competition guidelines. JMI will not take part in dialogue with any contestant who has been refused entry or otherwise infringes on the copyrights, trademarks, contract rights, or any other intellectual property rights of any third person or entity.
